## Application for Breed Booth Coordinator

Thank you for your interest in having a booth at the CSKC Meet the Breeds Event being held Sunday, November 6th at Under the Sun Dog Training and Daycare. As we all know, positive interaction with responsible breeders and quality representatives of purebred dogs can have a lasting impact on potential dog owners. Please read the following required expectations for having a booth at the event. If you can meet these expectations please complete the Booth Application found attached to this form. The committee will review your application and contact you with a confirmation of acceptance and/or ask any needed questions to help you with all the needed requirements. Please note that there will be only one booth for each breed in order to guarantee adequate space for exhibits and visitors. Please submit your application in a timely manner to ensure your breed and breeding are represented. The committee will do everything possible to help coordinate communication between similar breeds so everyone gets a chance to showcase their beautiful breed and breeding.

If you are **not** interested in being a Breed Booth Coordinator, but want to volunteer to bring your dog to represent the breed. We need you! Please fill out the volunteer information and we will forward your information on to your Breed's Booth Coordinator. Volunteers are always appreciated and welcome!

## Booth requirements:

- Each booth will need a designated booth coordinator/contact that will be the point of contact for the event organizers and be responsible for coordinating the set up, manning, and take down of the booth.
- Your booth will need to be set up by 9:00 am on November 6th.
- The event doors will open at 10:00 am and close at 3:00 pm. It is the responsibility of the Booth Coordinator to have the booth manned at all times with knowledgeable person(s) about the breed and breed representatives that are good ambassadors with the public.

- Please be ready to COMMIT fully to the success of the event. It will be the responsibility of the booth coordinator to develop a schedule for your booth and to have back ups in case people/dogs are not able to make their scheduled time.
- It is strongly suggested that you plan to have informational material/visuals to enhance the qualities of your breed. Think of ways to draw people into the uniqueness of your breed and entice them to want to talk to you further. I.e.
  - Human/dog treats
  - Showcase if participants present are a Breeder of Merit, Breeder of Heart, Breed Club recognitions (dam/sire of the year, breeder of the year, etc.)
  - Health testing that is required for the breed in order to educate those on the importance of purchasing well bred dogs
  - Visuals that appeal to all types of future dog owners (pictures, charts, videos, fact sheets, etc.)
  - Trivia type games about the breed's qualities are fun ways to draw people in. Costumes are often seen to share the heritage of the breeds.
- Each booth will be 8X10 and chairs will be available. Tables will **not** be provided, so please plan to bring your own. The facility has an artificial grass floor and is temperature controlled with the comfort of active dogs in mind.
- Please note that the booths will be set up alphabetically within their respective groups. There will be posters with generalized information/characteristics of each group to help educate visitors. You are encouraged to bring more information specific to your breed.
- All booths will be expected to follow the turf care guidelines set forth by Under the Sun Dog Training. Information will be provided. Thank you for helping take care of the facility.
- Demonstrations will be going on throughout the event. Maybe your breed has a certain propensity for an event? Please list it on the application if you are interested in participating in a demonstration.

Unloading on the day of the event:

- Begins at 6:00am in front east parking lot

Parking:

- Once unloaded all exhibitors and visitors will park on the west side of the facility. Please let your volunteers know where to park.

Packing up:

- Booths will pack up from 3:15pm to 5:00pm in the front east parking lot.
